1.	The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting and reminded them about the confidentiality rule applying to the meeting. No minutes from last meeting available.	Chair
2.	Report back from previous priority. ASB issues around town centre, memorial ground, willow area. Patrols regular have taken place.	Police
3. a.	Identifying future Priorities for the Neighbourhood Howdale Estate area suffering from inconsiderate parking and speeding during school term time. Concerns raised from speeding vehicles along "Lady Drove". A meeting between a member of the public and Head of Highways, NCC has taken place. Proposal to reduce speed limits from 40mph to 30mph will take years to introduce. "Severe" speeding noted along Station Rd, Ten mile Bank as early as 05.45am. Ten Mile Bank residents feeling "unsafe" a male has been seen entering gardens late at night. Private CCTV images taken of individual and willing to share picture to assist in identifying suspect. Members of a family from Magdelan made a number of comments from a recent neighbourhood issue of violence and wanting advice from attending officer. Same issues have also been made to senior officers within the constabulary.	Public public public public

Chair raised concerns about a single mum and her children as the next door neighbour at a location in Outwell is using CCTV that appears to be positioned overlooking into her garden.
